



Better Balance

Every Subaru is built for AWD from the ground up. This allows us to build a balanced, symmetrical drivetrain that is free of the extra components some other systems need to get power to all four wheels. This symmetry and balance means stability that makes driving your Subaru safer and agility that makes it more fun.

Quicker Response

There are only four small patches of rubber that keep you in control of your vehicle. The more your tires are engaged, the more control you have. Subaru keeps more power routed to all four tires than some other systems that only fully engage all wheels as a reaction to slippage that has already occurred.

Efficient Design

Because power in some adapted systems must route through extra components, these systems not only sacrifice efficiency, but also can incur more wear and tear. Subaru routes power directly from the engine to all four wheels to keep components—and frictional power losses—to a minimum.

Engine and Suspension

Rugged doesn't have to mean rough. Get behind the wheel of the Outback and you'll enjoy remarkable agility that begins with the SUBARU BOXER® engine. A lower center of gravity means this smooth engine actually helps maintain vehicle balance. A heavy-duty, 4-wheel independent suspension with generous ground clearance provides responsiveness and stability—not to mention the confidence to tackle adverse road conditions.

2.5i / 2.5XT / 3.0R

Outback is available with a variety of reliable engines. The 2.5i is powered by a 170-horsepower engine that delivers great gas mileage and low emissions. Those who enjoy a lift after a long day on the job or the slopes can get a potent 243 horsepower with the turbocharged 2.5XT. And, for ultra-smooth performance there's the 3.0R that provides 245 horsepower and 215 lb-ft of torque.

SI-Drive

Puts maximum performance or efficiency within easy reach. This available technology controls the performance characteristics of the Outback to suit your driving needs—or desires. Intelligent mode gets the best gas mileage possible, while Sport and Sport Sharp modes give you increasingly quick throttle response and acceleration.

Sportshift Transmissions

If you opt for the ease of the 4-speed or 5-speed automatic transmission, the SPORTSHIFT® manual control will allow you to take charge of how the Outback shifts for greater driver involvement and access to power when passing or climbing hills.



Cargo Capacity
