



In models with the 4-speed electronically controlled automatic transmission, Active All-Wheel Drive sends power where it's needed, when it's needed—not just in response to slippage, but also acceleration, braking and cornering. In Outback models with the standard 5-speed manual transmission, a viscous-coupling locking center differential provides equal power to the front and rear wheels. If one set of wheels slips, power is sent to the wheels with the best traction. Outback H6-3.0 VDC models provide the highest level of control with the advanced Variable Torque Distribution (VTD) All-Wheel Drive system working in conjunction with Vehicle Dynamics Control (VDC).*



All Outback H6-3.0 VDC models come standard with the Subaru Vehicle Dynamics Control (VDC) system. This system helps the driver maintain directional control under all driving conditions. Using inputs from the steering angle, yaw rate, lateral g-force and other sensors, the VDC system monitors vehicle stability and continuously compares it to the driver's intended path. If VDC detects instability, such as oversteer or understeer, it applies light brake pressure to a select wheel(s) to help restore control.

Powertrain components are laid out in a straight line and close to the chassis' centerline, giving agility while providing greater stability.



Outback H6-3.0 models feature the power and balance of an advanced 3.0-liter, 24-valve horizontally opposed boxer engine producing 212 horsepower and 210 lb.-ft. of low-end torque.


**TOP-LINE POWER, MAXIMUM CONTROL**

Outback H6-3.0 VDC Sedan and Wagon models combine a 212-horsepower 6-cylinder boxer engine with Vehicle Dynamics Control (VDC), the most sophisticated All-Wheel Drive system available in any Outback model. Leave it to Subaru to invent an All-Wheel Drive system so smart it helps keep the car going in the direction you're steering, even if a slippery road surface has other ideas. Variable Torque Distribution (VTD) All-Wheel Drive continuously adjusts distribution of torque between the front and rear wheels for optimum handling, control and traction for every road condition. Under normal driving conditions, more power is sent to the rear wheels to increase handling agility and provide more of a performance-driving feel. Should driving conditions cause the car to veer from your intended path, VDC uses stability control to instantly make a correction to help keep you on course. A 4-wheel, all-speed traction control system further enhances control in slippery weather. You can't control the weather, but with Outback H6-3.0 VDC, you don't have to let changes in the weather control your plans.





The proven Subaru H4 boxer engine in Outback and Outback Limited models produces a healthy 165 horsepower† and 166 lb.-ft. of torque to give you smooth, responsive performance on any road.



Ring-Shaped Reinforcement Frame construction is one reason that Outback models offer outstanding safety. This design ties together structural elements in the floor, sides and roof to form a strong steel cage that helps protect the passenger compartment should an accident occur.

### **THE STRONG PUNCH OF A BOXER**


The horizontally opposed, boxer engine is a cornerstone of Subaru technology. We believe this design provides the best combination of a lower center of gravity, smooth operation and long-term durability. A boxer engine concentrates its mass low in the car, and that helps make Outback an agile handler. Perhaps those are some of the reasons Porsche has kept this engine configuration for its legendary sports cars. In Outback and Outback Limited models, our proven 2.5-liter 4-cylinder boxer engine produces 165 horsepower† and 166 lb.-ft. of peak torque, giving these models quick response, especially at low and mid-range speeds. Our H4 engine also helps make these Outback models more fuel efficient than mid-size SUVs.



## OUTBACK MAKES FRIENDS WITH ANY ROAD

In Outback, feeling comfortable begins with the feeling that you can handle just about anything the road or weather throws your way. Here's another comforting notion... Outback Wagon handles better than Ford Explorer V6, Honda Pilot and Toyota Highlander V6 4WD on dry pavement, wet pavement and dirt.\* That's the Subaru "DNA" at work. A powerful boxer engine, 4-wheel fully independent suspension and Full-Time All-Wheel Drive give Outback reflexes that those SUVs just can't match. Our boxer engine and simple, symmetrical drivetrain layout provide balance that can make you feel more confident driving down a poorly lit back road on a rainy night. Every Outback model comes standard with a 4-channel/4-sensor Anti-lock Braking System (ABS) for maximum control during hard braking.

All Outback models except Outback Sport and Outback H6-3.0 VDC feature a standard limited-slip rear differential that further enhances rear wheel traction. If one rear wheel starts to lose traction, power is automatically diverted to the other rear wheel—all without the need for driver intervention.



As the body of a vehicle leans in a turn, the suspension of the inside wheel lengthens. All Outback models except Outback Sport feature a rebound spring inside the front strut that is designed to use the mass of the wheels, tires and brakes to resist this lengthening, reducing body roll in turns. The rebound spring also works to reduce the lift of the nose of the vehicle on acceleration.
