ENGINE

Horsepower. Once you get some, you always want more. That's why the all-new 2004 Dodge Durango features the 5.7L HEMI® Magnum® engine with a best-inclass 335 horsepower and 375 lb.-ft. of torque. That's up 90 hp from last year.

Other engines and features:

- 3.7L V6 provides 210HP and 235 lb.-ft. of torque
- 4.7L V8 provides 230HP and 290 lb.-ft. of torque
- These new engines deliver a 7-percent improvement in fuel efficiency
- Choice of four- or five-speed transmissions



SMOOTH RIDE

To get a really smooth ride out of most vehicles you need to pay extra to get the better suspension system. Not with this all-new Durango. It has a new, longer wheelbase and wider track, new rear suspension, new rack-and-pinion steering, torsion bar independent front suspension and an all-new hydroformed frame for added stiffness.

AIR BAGS AND SEAT BELTS

Durango offers and available side curtain airbag system for all three rows of seating and an advanced air bag system that includes multistage front airbags and an occupant classification system (OCS)* for the passenger side front air bag.

The OCS* measures the conditions for activation or deactivation of the passenger side air bag based upon the weight of the occupant.



* Always sit properly in the seat with the seat belt fastened. Always observe the passenger airbag indicator lamp to determine if the OCS classification is appropriate. Children 12 and under should always be in a back seat correctly using and infant or child restraint system or the seat belt positioned correctly for the child's age and weight.



TOWING AND HAULING

You can pack plenty inside Durango with 102.4 cu.-ft. of cargo volume and 1,780 lbs. of payload. Plus, if you equip it with the HEMI engine you'll get the best-in-class 8,950 lbs.* of towing capability that comes with it. Or opt for the other two powerful engines:

- 3.7L V6 Max towing capacity of 3,700 lbs
- 4.7L V8 Max towing capacity of 7,400 lbs*





SEATING

Are you one of those people who think SUVs are a dime a dozen? Odds are, you've never been inside the one-of-a-kind, all-new 2004 Dodge Durango.
