

All the power and finesse that these Pontiacs represent can be described with two words: Grand Prix. In the foreground is the potent and precise 303-hp V8 Grand Prix GXP, the most powerful sport sedan in its class.* To its right is the Grand Prix GT, which unites the enthusiast-inspiring power of the supercharged 3800 Series III V6 with the supple reflexes and responsive handling of a world-class performance sedan. The Grand Prix, cloaked here in the sinister Special Edition Appearance Package,** has next-generation WideTrack Handling, fully independent suspension, four-wheel disc brakes, and a list of standard features that leaves the competition no option but to move over to the right.

GRAND PRIX GXP:
WIDENING THE ADVANTAGE.

In the world of high-performance sport sedans, the only constant is that Grand Prix will accelerate the standard of comparison. The latest example is the Grand Prix GXP. Built around the foundation of a transversely mounted 303-hp 5.3L V8 and the specially designed WideTrack Handling system, GXP is a highly refined sport sedan with an assertive manner. But more impressive than the list of technical features is its purposeful sense of design. Evocatively styled and carefully detailed, its focus is singular: to stimulate and reward the discriminating driver at every opportunity.

THE NEW DEFINITION
OF SPORT SEDAN PERFORMANCE.

Today, a true performance machine is a complete system of interlocking technologies from road to roof that allows you to confidently explore more of the driving experience. In the GXP, rethinking the FWD sedan began with rethinking the front wheels. Its forged, flangeless 18" alloy wheels have nearly an extra inch of width per side, and when mounted with larger, speed-rated P255 tires give GXP a wider track in the front than in the rear. The increased contact area (or patch) puts extra traction at the driving wheels and helps the GXP to deliver lateral acceleration of .85g. The next link is the Performance Brake Package, with vented cross-drilled 12.7" front and 12.0" rear rotors, crowned with red powder-coated calipers from international brake specialist PBR, for a smooth, progressive feel even under hard use. These are mounted to a fully independent suspension with GXP-tuned springs, thick anti-roll bars, and premium monotube Bilstein gas-charged struts, tuned for a supple, well-controlled ride. Magnasteer II matches steering assist to your speed, while a four-channel ABS system provides additional control on uneven surfaces and in unpleasant weather. Monitoring the chassis is a task that falls to the StabiliTrak stability control system. One of the most advanced in the world, it compares steering inputs to vehicle response and selectively activates critical control inputs to help you stay on track. It is the type of control that not only defines GXP, but redefines the entire concept of the FWD sport sedan.


The 303-hp 5.3L V8 — in engineering parlance, the LS4 — could be called a triumph of technology over brute force. However, brute force would demand equal time. Because the LS4 is the most powerful engine in its class. And based on published data, it makes GXP the fastest-accelerating, when compared to Infiniti G35, BMW 330i, and Nissan Maxima 3.5 SE.

Press the standard keyless remote start, and you activate the engine created from the same basic materials and design as the GM Racing V8's that powered the Pontiac Daytona prototypes past BMW, Lexus, and Porsche for two consecutive years at the Rolex 24 Hours at Daytona, including the dramatic 1-2-3 finish in 2005.

Borrowing from lessons learned in competition, all-aluminum construction results in a complete V8 that actually weighs less than the supercharged V6. Its patented Displacement-on-Demand technology adaptively deactivates four cylinders under light throttle and light load conditions, then reactivates in milliseconds for extra power for fuel economy comparable to many V6's — 17/28 mpg city/highway.*




The power to extract maximum performance from the 5.3L V8 is at your fingertips with the Formula One-inspired TAPshift manual automatic. You can manually select upshifts and downshifts without removing your hands from the wheel. This allows enthusiast drivers to keep the power in the sweet spot.




Not coincidentally, those shifts allow you to enjoy the intoxicating sound emanating from the dual exhaust with quad polished stainless tips.

With all 303 horses summoned, the GXP can stampee from 0-60 mph on the GM test track in 5.7 seconds, performance that may be as eye-opening to you as it is to GXP's competition. For details of that experience, turn the page.

PUTTING REPUTATIONS ON THE LINE:
GRAND PRIX GXP VS. NISSAN MAXIMA 3.5 SE.

Comparing GXP specifications on paper against its competition is one thing. Putting them to the test on the track, where their limits can be fully explored, is quite another. That's where the experts from ProFormance come in. Performance is their profession, wringing out the latest and greatest in a series of dynamic tests certified by the SCCA, using the SCCA's Performance and Handling Index.

The competitive machine of choice was the Nissan Maxima 3.5 SE, the sport sedan most statistically and spiritually similar to the Grand Prix GXP. After a brief "break-in" session to check vehicle performance and familiarize the drivers with the machines, we subjected GXP and Maxima to a grueling battery of tests, including 0-60 and quarter-mile acceleration, 60-0 braking, 100' skid pad lateral acceleration, and finally a .06 mile composite road course.

The results speak for themselves. Head to head, Grand Prix GXP surpassed the Maxima 3.5 SE in every single category. GXP walked away in 0-60 acceleration and the quarter-mile times. Stopped shorter from 60 mph. Pulled more lateral g's, maneuvered the slalom, and ran the composite road course faster. Shift? We'd call it seismic.

IN THE CENTER OF THE STORM.



The power to bend the performance of GXP to your will is literally at your fingertips. The driver's position is intimate, personal, and focused purely on the enjoyment of driving. At first, you notice the subtle metallic accents that set off the rich textures that cover every surface. Attractive and breathable Mini-perf leather covers the shifter and steering wheel; contrasting stitching highlights those controls, plus the console and seat bolsters (when you order Ebony leather-appointed seats.) Grand Prix's signature high-bolster sport seats are swathed by handsome fabrics, or they can be upgraded to leather with UltraLux suede inserts.

Wrap your hands around the hand-stitched leather-wrapped steering wheel and your fingertips fall naturally to strategically placed controls

for entertainment and information, including the black finished paddles for the electronically controlled TAPshift manual automatic.

Vital performance information is presented on easily read white-on-black gauges that backlight in red for enhanced nighttime visibility. Look up, and you're in the crosshairs of the jet-inspired Head-Up Display (HUD), which projects vital information on a focus point well down the road. It can be dimmed to your desire by activating stealth mode.

GXP also features a number of engaging options, including a voice-activated DVD-based* navigation and entertainment system with LCD readout screens, available 200-watt Monsoon audio, and the unsurpassed variety of XM Satellite Radio,** which



features over 150 channels, including 67 channels of 100% commercial-free music. With XM, you get the best in music, news, talk, comedy, XM Instant Traffic & Weather, and sports. As you would expect from the Official Performance Machines of the NCAA®, your subscription now includes nine NCAA channels dedicated to the ACC, Pac-10, and Big Ten conference football and men's and women's basketball. Plus, you can get three trial months of service with factory-installed XM without any contract or obligation. After you experience it once, AM and FM are just not the same.



From small touches like the perforated leather that covers hands-on controls, to the broad clean sweep of its organized and informative interior, Grand Prix GT is a precise and willing touring machine that wants for nothing—but a driver with the desire to use it to the fullest.




Born from elements that earned the title of one of the "Ten Best Engines of the Millennium," the 3800 Series III V6 is the cornerstone of Grand Prix's performance reputation. Every part is touched with the obsession for power, durability, and refinement.

Standard in Grand Prix is a 200-hp 3800 Series III V6 that ranks among the largest V6 engines in the class, no small advantage where four-cylinders are the norm. Refined for 2006, it features a host of improvements including polymer-coated pistons that dampen vibrations, and continues with a new emission control system that attains a SULEV (Super Ultra Low Emission Vehicle) rating, meaning it runs 90% cleaner than the average vehicle sold in 2003. Its platinum-tipped spark plugs and long-life engine coolant are designed to last up to 100,000 miles in normal service;* its transmission normally needs no service or maintenance for the life of the vehicle.

The supercharged 260-horsepower 3800 Series III V6 is standard in Grand Prix GT. With 280 lb-ft of torque, it has a following bordering on cult status. The credit for its popularity falls largely to the Eaton Gen V supercharger. Borrowing from competition practice, the rotors have an advanced powder Teflon-like coating (APC) that permits tighter clearances for greater boost pressure, while drawing less engine power. The drive-by-wire Electronic Throttle Control (ETC) has 19 discrete response "maps" that sense your driving situation and deliver the appropriate engine response, from parallel parking to highway passing.

A POWERFUL ORGANIZING PRINCIPLE.



Take your seat and the power of intelligent design to amplify the driving experience becomes obvious. Everywhere you look and every surface you touch is designed to reward your senses and enhance your feeling of control.

While its styling suggests its sensuous coupe heritage, Grand Prix is a four-door that takes the passengers as seriously as the driver. Not only are the rear doors sized for easy access, their hinges feature a third detent, allowing a near-90 degree opening span for large objects.

Accessing those dimensions could convince you that Grand Prix has strong SUV traits. For example, in less time than it takes to read this, both sides of the 60/40 rear seatback fold for pass-through access to the trunk. Flip the lever on the available fold-flat front passenger seat, and you can more than triple Grand Prix's cargo capacity, from an already generous 16 cu. ft. to 57 cu. ft. — a transformation impossible in a Nissan Maxima. This maneuver also opens an uninterrupted span that can accommodate oversized items essential



to your lifestyle from building materials to sporting goods. Need a place to put wet gear? Just flip the available reversible trunk mat. Check the "Sun and Sound" option to experience 200 watts of Monsoon sound from nine strategically placed speakers, while you fill the interior with light from a large retractable glass sunroof.

After even a few moments inside, you'll discover Grand Prix not only responds to your lifestyle, it encourages it.







The foundation of performance and style is always safety and quality. Fortunately, Grand Prix already has a head start on the competition. It is produced at the GM Oshawa #2, Ontario, facility that was just awarded J.D. Power and Associates' Gold Plant Quality Award, North/South America.* Their dedication to quality is elevating the Grand Prix's reputation. And raising the stakes for everyone else.



- a. Over 97% of its welds are done robotically, and measured to the thousandth of an inch — a fraction of the thickness of this page.
- b. Spark plugs and engine coolant are engineered for up to 100,000-mile durability.** Transmission, brake, and steering fluids are sealed systems that do not normally require changing under normal driving conditions.
- c. Safety cage construction helps to maintain passenger compartment integrity in a collision.






